She is the Accredited Family Mediation Supervisor delivering Family Mediation Service, providing live supervision for Family Mediation Trainees and coaching for accredited mediation training courses approved by HKMAAL; and the Parenting Coordinator delivering co-parenting counseling and parenting coordination service to the high conflicts co-parents. She is also the clinical leader of the Project: A Beam of Hope – Pilot Project on “Child-focused” Parenting Coordination & Co-parenting Services for Divorced Families.
